Finding Articles in Google Scholar

1.) After conducting a search in Google Scholar, you will find that the search results will have Full-Text links to the right of the results list. Note that not all search results will be available full-text.



2.) Click on "Full-Text @ CUC" link for access. If you are off campus, an authentication page will open in your web browser. Enter your Concordia username and password at the prompts, and then click Login to continue.
