TEACH Grant Application

The Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant program provides grants of up to \$3,772 per year (effective on or after 10/1/20) to Graduate students who intend to teach in a public or private elementary or secondary school that serves students from low-income families.

To receive a TEACH grant you must:

- Have an undergraduate cumulative GPA of at least 3.25.
- Submit official transcripts from your undergraduate post-secondary institution, where you obtained your Bachelors Degree, to the Office of Financial Aid.

Or

■ Have a current cumulative GPA of at least 3.25 for each subsequent term.

And

- Be enrolled in an eligible program, designed to prepare students to teach in a **high need field**.
 - o Eligible programs are Special Education, Curriculum and Instruction with an ESL endorsement, Reading Education, and English as Second Language.
- Complete the FAFSA each year.
- Agree to serve as a full time teacher in a high need field for at least four academic years within eight years of completing the program for which you received the TEACH grant.
- Sign a TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve each year you receive the TEACH grant.
- Complete TEACH Grant Entrance Counseling each year you receive the TEACH grant.

IF YOU DO NOT COMPLETE THE REQUIRED TEACHING SERVICE, THE GRANT WILL BE CONVERTED TO AN <u>UNSUBSIDIZED LOAN</u> AND INTEREST WILL BE CHARGED FROM THE DATE OF EACH TEACH GRANT DISBURSEMENT.
