Summer/Fall, 2017 starts announced for three new Master's dual degree programs

Concordia-Chicago's <u>Accelerated Degree Program</u> (ADP) has experienced continuous growth since its AA and BA programs in organizational management were first offered in 1990. In response to interest among current ADP students wishing to continue their education by moving into a master's degree program, the ADP department has developed three new dual degree programs. The <u>Master's in Business Administration</u>; the <u>MA, Leadership Studies</u>; and the <u>MA, Sports Leadership</u> are currently enrolling students to join the inaugural cohorts, set to launch in the summer of 2017.

What are Dual Degrees?

Through careful planning and academic advising, students completing an ADP bachelor's degree at Concordia-Chicago can move seamlessly into a master's degree program. Dual degree master's courses are delivered online in an accelerated, 8-week format and, in the case of the MBA, on campus.

Who is eligible for the Dual Degree program?

Dual degrees are available to Concordia-Chicago ADP students who have completed their bachelor's degree while maintaining a GPA of at least 2.85.

What are the benefits of the Dual Degree program?

Dual degrees offer Concordia-Chicago ADP students a seamless transition into a master's degree program. Because select courses in the master's curriculum are waived, students benefit from a reduced tuition expense and may move more swiftly toward program completion. A streamlined admission process waives recommendation letters, application fee, and GRE. Transcript services are provided upon full completion of the ADP degree.
